On the nose this is a wine with animal tones, farm yard notes, cherries, red currants and rose hip. On the palate there are vibrant currants, tart Pomegranite and rose hip . The mouth evolves into tones of burnt toast and mineral notes. The tannins are firm but smooth releasing into nutmeg and Cinamon spices. A truly incredible delivery of a Bordeaux, never dissapoints and gets even better with decanting for about an hour. I would suggest a pairing of lamb or duck.
